

Psychology Major (B.S.) Suggested Course Sequence

Based on 2019-20 Catalog

This Suggested Course Sequence is a potential plan for how to complete the major within four years. Please consult with your faculty advisor for guidance and regularly review your Degree Status Check in Banner to make sure you are on track with all of your degree requirements.

First Year:

- ✓ Begin or resume elementary foreign language, if competency requirement is not complete.
- ✓ Unless you are exempt, take the Math Placement Test at least three academic quarters before you intend to register for Statistics.
- ✓ Transfer students should take PSY 1200 the first quarter they are able to register.
- ✓ Choose a B.S. track: Psychological Science, Behavioral Neuroscience, or Animal Behavior.
- ✓ Apply to major in Banner in the first two weeks of any quarter after completing PSY 1180 and PSY 1200. Minimum C- grade required in both courses.
- ✓ Attend New Major Orientation upon admission to the major.
